



## Hotel Energy Uplift Program

### *Energy savings grants for hotels*

Small to medium hotels can apply for grants of up to \$25,000 for energy savings projects through this \$10.2 million Australian Government initiative. Grants will support these hotels to reduce their energy costs, reinvest in their business and create local jobs.

### *Who are the grants aimed at?*

Small and medium hotels, motels and serviced apartment complexes with 1-99 guestrooms.

### *What are the grants for?*

To help small and medium hotels save energy and reduce power bills through:

- upgrading equipment and appliances like airconditioning, lighting and refrigeration
- building fabric upgrades such as installing double glazing and insulation
- undertaking energy management activities and assessments, such as energy audits and engineering feasibility studies for energy efficiency upgrades
- investing in energy monitoring and management systems.

### *How much are the grants?*

Between \$10,000 and \$25,000, with no co-contribution required.

### *When do applications open?*

Applications open on 24 February 2021 and will close on 1 April 2021 (or until funding is exhausted in each jurisdiction).
